Welcome back to a new academic year at Ark Helenswood Academy! Term 1 started this morning with a celebration of the fantastic exam results from our GCSE and A level students this summer, and this was of course an opportunity for all of our girls to recognise the importance of hard work, determination and a growth mindset of self-belief as I shared the successes of our outgoing Year 11 and Year 13 students. 62% of our students achieved A\*-C grades in five GCSE courses, including English and maths; with 99% of our students achieving a GCSE grade in their subjects. We pride ourselves on our examination success simply because we know that this then opens doors for our students as they move into our 6<sup>th</sup> form, onto vocational courses at college and then onto apprenticeships and university. A huge congratulations from all of the team here at Helenswood to all of our girls as they move into 6<sup>th</sup> form and onwards in their careers post-18, we look forward to hearing of your success. ### **Sending money into the academy:**

We operate a cashless catering system at Ark Helenswood, and I would encourage you to place funds on your daughter's lunch money account by visiting your account at Parentmail +Pay. We will be asking for payments for all school trips and financial requirements to be paid via this method as we prefer students not to carry large amounts of money into school. For those of you who have not yet registered for an account a letter will be sent to you in the near future with the necessary details.

However, if you do need to send money into school for payments please can I ask that it is sent in an **envelope, which is clearly marked with your daughter's name, tutor group, the amount enclosed, and what the payment is for e.g. Art book, trip deposit, etc.**
