**Re: Year 11 Prom**

We are now heading towards the final part of the school year for Y11 and so I am writing to you to confirm the arrangements for the annual Y11 Prom. This is a truly wonderful celebration of the end of KS4 and students enjoy getting together with their peers from Ark William Parker to mark the end of KS4 before they start their 6<sup>th</sup> form career. Students are not permitted to invite guests from other local academies – the Y11 Prom is strictly for those students who attend either Ark Helenswood Academy or Ark William Parker Academy.

As in previous years we will be expecting all students to achieve a minimum of 10 revision stamps on their Revision Card. These are gained when attending revision sessions after school, at lunchtimes or during the Easter holidays. All students will need to produce this completed card in order to purchase their Prom Ticket.

I do need to point out that those students not adhering to the academy expectations for attendance and behaviour will not be invited to the prom. Specifically, this is any student in receipt of an exclusion from the academy, either internal or external. In addition, any student who accumulates any more than 10 BFL points or has less than 90% attendance from Monday 14<sup>th</sup> March onwards will not be invited to the prom. Students have been informed of these expectations in an assembly this morning. I will be writing to you again soon with an invite for your daughter, should she meet these expectations, confirming further details.

I hope that you will support us in reiterating these standards to your daughter and I look forward to inviting her to the Ark Helenswood Academy Prom 2016.
