English Language Coursework

Overview:

- A speech – marked for writing
- A piece of creative or descriptive work – marked for writing
- A letter responding to a newspaper article – marked for reading and writing

Weighting: 40%

This was written last year. Some students will be improving this work this year during after school sessions.

English Language Speaking and Listening

Overview:

Students will write and rehearse a 3-4 minute speech. This will be performed to their teacher.

The teacher will ask questions about the topic for a further 6-7 minutes.

Students are marked for the quality of their initial speech, the content of their answers and the relevance of the answers to the question asked.

Weighting: 20%

English Language Exam

Overview:

2 hours

3 questions

Question 1: Read a text and write from a prescribed point of view.

Question 2: Comment on the language and effects.

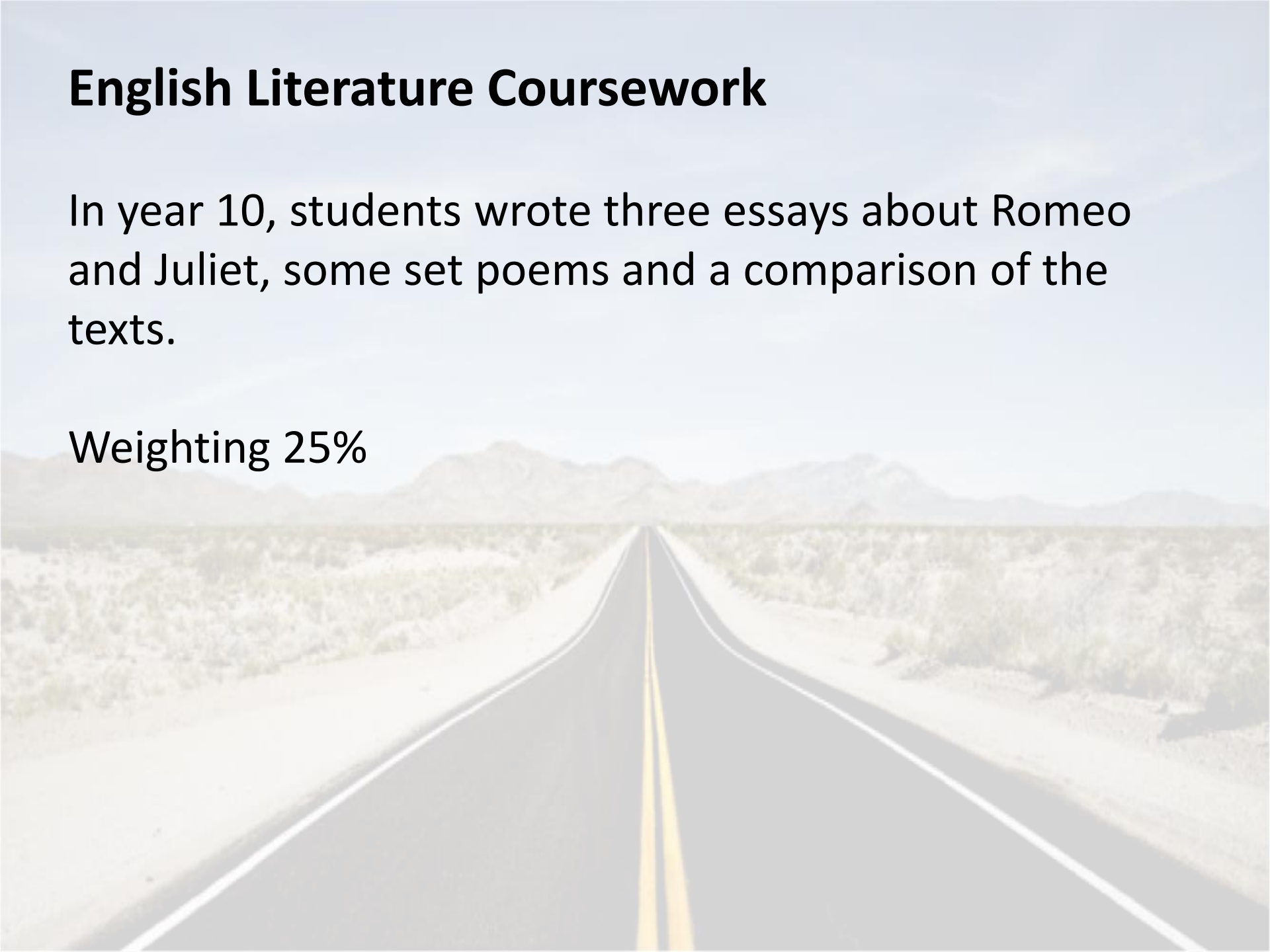
Question 3: Read a text, find information and summarise it.

Weighting: 40%

English Literature Coursework

In year 10, students wrote three essays about Romeo and Juliet, some set poems and a comparison of the texts.

Weighting 25%



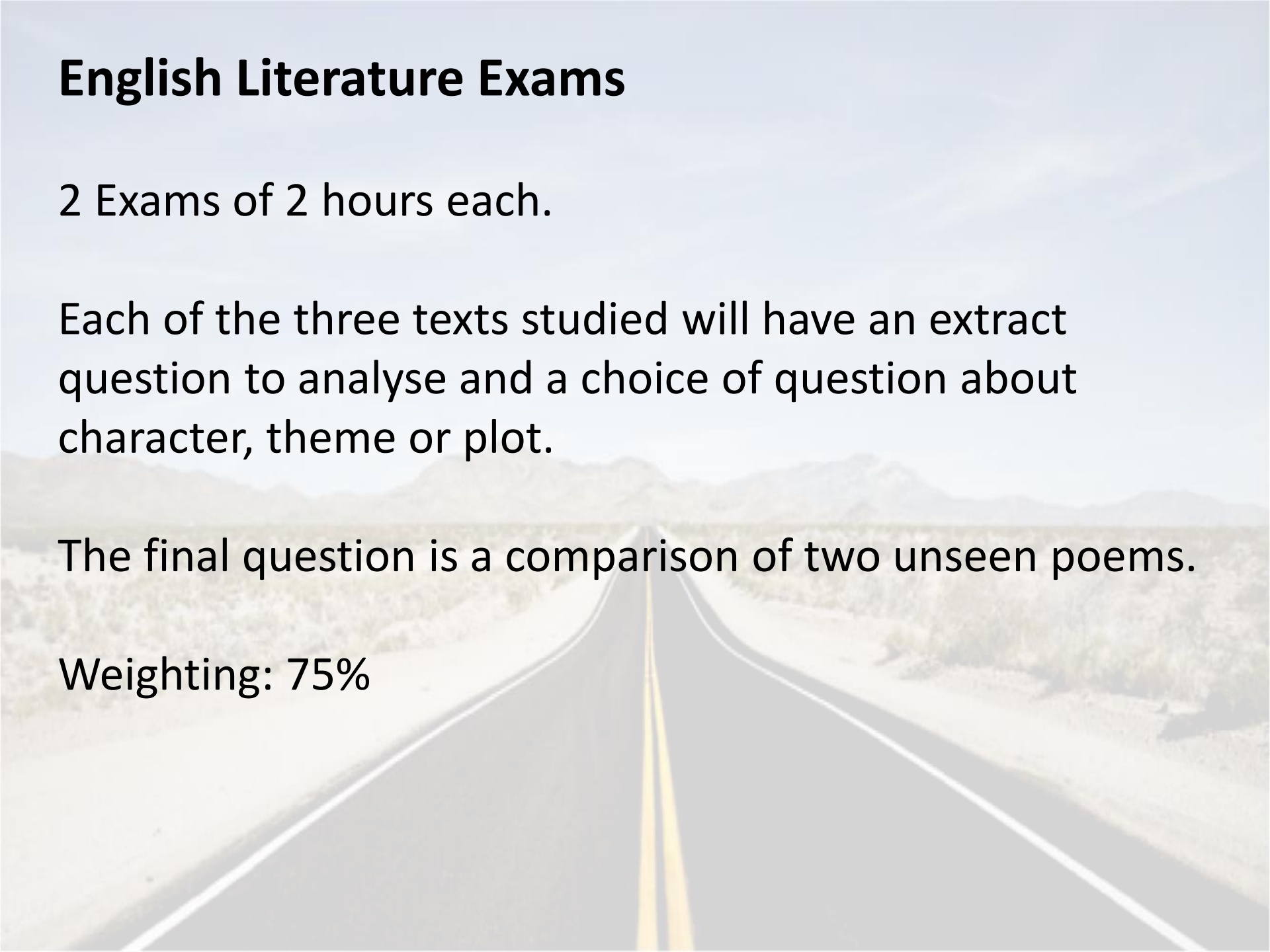
English Literature Exams

2 Exams of 2 hours each.

Each of the three texts studied will have an extract question to analyse and a choice of question about character, theme or plot.

The final question is a comparison of two unseen poems.

Weighting: 75%
